

# Advanced Rigid Heddle Loom

Sponsored by the Southwest Women's Fiber Arts Collective

If you took SWFAC's Beginning Rigid Heddle Loom workshop earlier this year, or are somewhat familiar with rigid heddle looms, this class is for you! Students will learn how to use a warping board and will make a warp for a project, put it on the loom and weave it. The project will be a small table runner in mercerized cotton, approximately 10" wide by 36" long.

In addition to weaving the runner, students will learn methods to finish the ends, and how to wet-finish the runner at home. SWFAC will provide looms, pearl cotton yarns, warping boards, and scissors. Students may bring yarns of their own after consulting with Tina.

**Biography of the Instructor:** Tina Salmon has been weaving for 14 years as well as selling her work in several galleries across the U.S. She has taught beginning weaving and recently has taught rigid heddle classes for SWFAC. You can see her woven and knitted work at The Common Thread Gallery in Silver City.

**When:** Saturday, June 14, 2008, 9 am-3 pm. (Students can bring a lunch or snack and something to drink.)

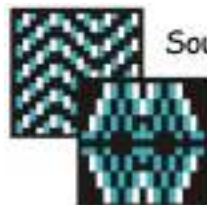
