

“Living on the Edge” A Series of Knitting Workshops
Sponsored by the Southwest Women’s Fiber Arts Collective

Learn to make beautiful knitted edgings to enhance home or fashion items. Each independent workshop will cover a different edging that might be used to embellish a purchased towel or pillowcase or to provide the finishing touch to the neckline, sleeves or other edges of a garment.

Biography of the Instructor

Sandra Jefferies has knitted for over 29 years, and teaches regularly in the Phoenix, AZ metropolitan area as well as other locations in the southwest. She teaches beginners to advanced knitters of all ages and has developed classes and handouts that hone all aspects of knitting. Along with her teaching skills, she designs, dyes fibers with plant material, sews, spins fiber, and weaves.

Prerequisites: Some knitting experience. These workshops are suitable for a range of skills from beginning to advanced.

Supplies: Yarn from your stash to practice on and needles of appropriate size. For pillowcase or towel edging you may wish to use cotton thread with small (#1) needles. The knitting supplies can be bought at Yada Yada Yarn, 614 N. Bullard Street, Silver City, 575-388-3350. Owner Suzi Calhoun will give students a 10% discount on class materials (except for sale items), so please mention that you are taking Sandra’s class.
