

## **“Beginning and Intermediate Silk Painting and Surface Design”** **Sponsored by the Southwest Women’s Fiber Arts Collective**

In this class you will create two small silk scarves using textural and Serti silk painting (gutta resist) techniques. The class will cover different types of silk dyes and stretchers, textural and gutta resist surface design techniques, and setting up a simple home steamer.

**Biography of the Instructor:** Blythe Whiteley is a self-taught artist who has been painting on silk for 15 years. She has also done painting and drawing, mask-making, fashion and costume design, floral art, beadwork, sculpture, jewelry, lampwork glass beadmaking, and ceramics. She has taught to all age levels in a variety of settings. Her hand-painted scarves are on display and for sale in The Common Thread.

**Prerequisites (if any):** There are no prerequisites for this class.

**Supplies:** Pencil and paper for note taking.

**When:** Saturday, February 20, 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. A lunch of homemade soup and bread is included, but you may bring a snack or bag lunch if you wish.

**Where:** 876 E. Pine Street, Silver City (instructor’s studio).

**Cost:** \$25 for current SWFAC members, \$30 for others with full payment required to register. There is an additional \$15 material fee to be paid to Instructor at the beginning of the class. The materials fee includes two silk scarves and all supplies. You can register by mail, visit or phone:
