

# **“Beginning Rug Hooking”**

## **Sponsored by the Southwest Women’s Fiber Arts Collective**

Learn the basic skills of rug hooking—how to create the picture and how to finish a piece—and create a small wall hanging.

**Biography of the Instructor:** Julie Salem had been a quilter for more than 10 years when she took up rug hooking in 1996. Seeing a little rug with a picture of a pig started her off in this new direction. She likes rug hooking because “you never know for sure exactly what you will get”! Some of Julie’s pieces are in Wild West Weaving on Texas Street in Silver City.

**Prerequisites (if any):** None

**Supplies:** A sturdy plastic embroidery or quilting hoop about 9 1/2” in diameter. All other supplies—backing, wool, and a hook--will be provided as part of the \$60 materials fee.

**When:** Saturday, March 27, 10 am – noon.

**Where:** The Common Thread, 107 W. Broadway St., Silver City

**Cost:** \$12 for current SWFAC members, \$17 for others with full payment required to register. There is an additional \$60 materials fee to be paid to Instructor at the beginning of the class. You can register by mail, visit or phone:
