

Folded Fabric Fun

Make small bags, flowers, and holiday ornaments by folding fabric, with minimal sewing. The folding techniques are inspired by Japanese origami and by an English method known as Somerset patchwork.

Biography of the Instructor: Kathy Cole has been sewing since a small child and quilting since her retirement twelve years ago. She has taught numerous techniques at quilt guild meetings!

Prerequisites (if any): Basic hand-sewing skills would be helpful, but you can learn on the spot, if necessary.

Supplies: Basic hand sewing supplies (needles, pins, thread, thimble (if you use one), scissors for snipping thread), pencil, and a small ruler. (If you do not have these supplies, contact the instructor, and she will provide you!) All other materials will be provided.

When: Saturday, October 22, 1 to 4 p.m.

Where: The Common Thread, 107 W. Broadway, Silver City

Cost: \$5 for current SWFAC members, \$15 for others with full payment required to register. There is an additional \$5 material fee to be paid to Instructor at the beginning of the class. You can register by mail, visit or phone:
