

## “Color for Quilters”

### Sponsored by the Southwest Women’s Fiber Arts Collective

Come to a better understanding of the effective use of color in quilts through examples and hands-on color exercises. Understanding the universal art harmonies and the effects of color will help you with this challenging step of the quilt making process. The class is based on the required book “Color and Cloth” by Mary Coyne Penders and has homework.

**Biography of the Instructor:** Lynn Welsch has been making quilts and studying quilting techniques for 30+ years. Her art quilts have been juried into a Hoffman Challenge traveling exhibit, American Quilting Society shows in Paducah, Kentucky, International Quilt Festival Shows in Houston, Texas, a National Quilting Association show, and a Studio Art Quilters Association show. Lynn has taught classes on miniature paper piecing, landscape quilt design, and quilt studio design, in addition to color for quilters.

**Prerequisites (if any):** There are no prerequisites. Class is appropriate for all skill levels.

**Supplies:** For first class: “Color and Cloth” by Mary Coyne Penders (required: used copies available on Amazon.com); glue stick, 20-30 pieces of fabric you like to work with from your collection (these will not be cut or used), paper and pencil. Supply list for classes 2 through-6 available at sign-up and will be discussed at the first class.

**When:** 9:30 a.m.-noon, 6 Thursdays: May 20 & 27, June 3, 10, 17 & 24.

**Where:** Thunder Creek Quilt Shop, 703 N. Bullard, Silver City.
