There is so much space for experimenting! While hiking I collect material to build structures that I cover with my paper and turn it into lamps (light sculptures). See them at the store!

**Supplies:** Just bring the paper you made in previous class or you can buy some from instructor

**Where:** The Common Thread, 107 W Broadway Street, Silver City NM

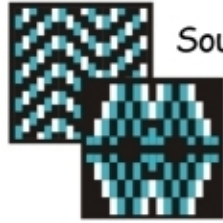
